The Patron of the Arts Giving Society was established in 2007 to support the extensive visual and performing arts program at Loretto High School. In many ways, the Visual and Performing Arts (VPA) Department is the community face of Loretto because students frequently display their creative skills off campus, both as representatives of our school and also as members of other ensembles.

The accomplishments of students in the VPA Department at Loretto are many and varied. Over just the past four years alone, in addition to receiving many awards, Loretto students and ensembles have performed at the Memorial Auditorium, Community Center Theater, and Mondavi Center, and performed with the Sacramento Choral Society and Orchestra, Sacramento Ballet, Music Circus, Sacramento Children's Chorus, Sacramento Theater Company, and countless other community organizations. Likewise, the Sacramento region is keenly aware of the extraordinary talent of many of Loretto's current and former visual arts students, and this is reflected in the fact that students are routinely invited to participate in gallery showing throughout the community, with several having won awards in a wide variety of artistic media.

The VPA Department at Loretto High School works to develop and nurture the talents of our students because we know the inestimable value of the arts and arts education. Obviously, extensive training in performance or fabrication courses is indispensable for students who are seeking to find placement in schools of art, drama, or music, but even for those seeking careers in other fields, our courses impart critical life skills such as poise, professionalism, self discipline, personal expression, creativity, communication, and teamwork at every level. We hold as a core belief that the creative impulse is a central part of what it means to be made in the image of God – just as God created the heavens and the earth, so we too create. Likewise, as members of the body of Christ we take seriously our responsibility to give back to the community whenever possible. In the past three years alone, Loretto choirs have helped to raise nearly \$10,000 for local charitable organizations including Wellspring Women's Center, Mustard Seed School, Cristo Rey High School, and Project Hope.


